



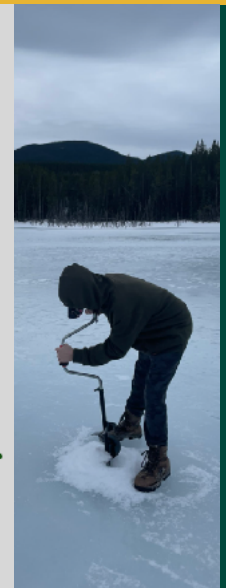
ARE YOU A K-12 EDUCATOR WITH INTEREST OR EXPERIENCE IN PLACE-RESPONSIVE LEARNING?
